SECTION 3: CIRCULATION OF MATERIALS Part 3: Lost and Damaged Items

- 1. Material that is lost or substantially damaged by a borrower shall be paid for at the current list price. If a current price for an item cannot be determined from standard sources, a determination shall be made by the Director for the reasonable value of the item. All lost or substantially damaged items will incur a \$5.00 processing fee. Fines will not be collected in addition to these charges.
- 2. The price for all Interlibrary loan material is set by the lending library.
- 3. Money collected for lost material will not be refunded if material is subsequently found and returned.
- 4. Damaged items may be given to the borrower when payment in full is made. However, the Library will not hold damaged materials for longer than 30 days from receipt.
- 5. Material that has been damaged but is able to be returned to circulation will be assessed a fee at the discretion of the Director.
- 6. Charges for lost or damaged audio visual cases and other misc. pieces will be of sufficient amount to return the item to circulation.
