SECTION 9: MEETING ROOMS, EXHIBIT AREAS, AND BULLETIN BOARDS PART 4: Bulletin Boards, Flyers, and Pamphlets

The Bradley Public Library District maintains a Community Bulletin Board near the entry to the building. The bulletin board provides organizations and businesses the ability to publicize events that are of civic, cultural, educational and recreational interest as well as job openings and employment training opportunities. The library does not advocate or endorse the viewpoints of any group or individual. Duration of postings is at the discretion of library staff. Postings can be no larger than 11"x17".

The library maintains a Literature Display Rack adjacent to the building entrance. The literature display rack provides a place for organizations and businesses to display pamphlets and multiple copies of flyers of civic, cultural, educational, recreational, or employment related interest. The library does not advocate or endorse the viewpoints of any group or individual. Duration of display is at the discretion of library staff. In the event that the display rack becomes overfull, space preference will be given to materials from educational, government, and non-profit institutions.

No pamphlets, flyers, or other materials from non-library sources may be displayed outside of the designated Bulletin Board or Literature Display Rack without the express approval of the Library Director, Reference Services Department Head, or Children's Services Department Head.
