SECTION 3: CIRCULATION OF MATERIALS

Part 2: Overdue Materials

- The Library does not charge fines on overdue materials with the exception of special collections including Equipment which is outlined in Part 3 of this section.
- 2. Fines stop accruing at \$10 per item unless otherwise noted.
- 3. Patrons with unpaid charges of \$10.00 or more will have borrowing privileges suspended until unpaid charges are below \$10.00.
- 4. Patrons with items more than 21 days overdue will have their borrowing privileges suspended until the items are returned.
- 5. Patrons will be billed for items overdue more than 21 days. If the items are returned in good condition within 1 year of the bill date, all charges will be waived.
- 6. If an item is not returned within 1 year of the bill date, the item will have been replaced or withdrawn from the collection and the Library will no longer waive replacement fees.
- Parents or legal guardians will have privileges suspended as above if the juvenile card for which they signed incurs a lost, damaged, or long overdue item.
- 8. The Library will attempt to notify patrons of overdue materials and is not responsible for a patron's failure to receive notifications.
- Bradley Public Library District patrons who check out materials at other libraries will be subject to that library's circulation policies including any overdue fines.
